



COUNTRY FLAG AND SIGN GUIDELINES

Delegations should have both a *flag* and a *sign* for each country they are representing at KUNA. Flags and signs will be carried by ambassadors from each country during the **Parade of Nations** at the opening of the conference.

FLAG: Each delegation is responsible for bringing a version of their country's national flag.

- Schools should have *one (1) flag per country* represented by that school.
- Flags may be purchased, handmade, or recycled from use at a previous conference.
- There are no specified size dimensions for the flag; however, it MUST be carried in the Parade of Nations by <u>no more than one person</u>.
- Each school must assign an ambassador to serve as the **Flag Bearer** for their country. This person <u>MAY NOT</u> be a Candidate or Leadership Team Applicant.

SIGN: Each delegation is responsible for creating a sign containing the name of their country.

- Schools should have one (1) sign per country represented by that school.
- Signs *must be made by students* and may be 2- or 3-dimensional. (Examples include: placards, papier-mâché objects, a student in costume, etc.)
- Students are encouraged to be creative in representing their country's culture by their sign design; however, each sign *must display the country's name*.
- There are no specified dimensions for the sign; however, it MUST be carried in the Parade of Nations by *no more than one person*.
- Each school must assign an ambassador to serve as the **Sign Bearer** for their country. This person <u>MAY NOT</u> be a Candidate or Leadership Team Applicant.
