## **NATIVE ATTIRE**

Students may wear appropriate native attire (with optional native headdress) on the first night of the conference.

- Native Attire should be a *serious* representation of a country's indigenous or historical culture. Disrespecting the tradition of a country will not be tolerated.
- Students are encouraged to *make* their costumes rather than purchasing them.
- Native Attire MUST be <u>within conference dress code</u>.
- Inappropriate attire will disqualify a school from nomination for major awards.
- Native Attire MAY NOT be worn after the first night of the conference. Delegations
  wishing to add a piece of their native attire (such as a sash or native headdress) to
  their second-day professional dress must have the approval of their Regional
  Director.
- Shoes must be worn <u>AT ALL TIMES</u>.
