Title: An act to establish medical schools for teaching purposes in the Central African Republic.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: There are 240,534 square miles in CAR with only four hospitals and one medical practitioner. The citizens of CAR are denied proper medical care due to a lack of medical knowledge. Our country requests medical facilities built for teaching purposes to educate practicing doctors and nurses.

Section I: Many deadly diseases, such as Hepatitis A, are spread through drinking contaminated water. Each year, 3,742,482 citizens die from a disease that can be easily cured with proper medical care.

Section II: CAR requests the United Nations department of Countries in Special Situations to fund the construction of additional facilities with teaching divisions. These medical facilities will ensure the citizens of CAR receive the proper medical care deserved.

Section III: CAR requests 1.5 million dollars. Upon passage of funding, construction of these facilities will begin by year end 2015.
