Title: An act to recognize the Republic of Ocea so it can trade freely with other nations.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: Each year thousands of dollars are lost by fishermen, paying taxes to countries they've never seen. This is because they are the descendents of people that immigrated to a nation that doesn't legally exist. Mongolia has recognize the Federal Republic of Ocea, and is a trading partner, receiving large amounts of fish and fresh fruit.

Section I: This is a bill for the United Nations to recognize the Federal Republic of Ocea's sovereignty. The Republic will require no assistance in setting up a functional independent government since there has been one since 1920. There is also a power grid, roads, and medical infrastructure in place.

Section II: The Federal Republic of Ocea (FRO) on an annual bases produces more than twice the food it needs, most of the excess is sent to Mongolia, the Republics only trade partner. Before 1965 a large sum of food was sent to Africa, but outside nations, such as Russia, have prohibited trade with some of these nations. If the Republic was granted complete independence it would be able to trade anywhere with no limitations. There would also be less piracy in prime trading zones, by setting a new Navy on the seas to defend common interest.

Section III: The United Nations could not punish any nation for not recognizing the FRO but he Republic could legally declare war if oppression occurs, and ask for support and aid from other nations. If so, it would be up to the discretion of that nation to supply aid, or of what kind of aid to send.

Section IV: Upon passage, this will go into effect January 20, 2014
