Title: An act to harshen the penalties for sexual abuse and human trafficking.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: In 2009 320 know cases of sexual abuse or human trafficking were reported in the country of Romania alone. Comparing Romania to the state of Oregon in population this amount of cases would increase by a minimum of 3000 times, making the global number of sexual abuse and human trafficking cases in the millions. A 66% of the Romanians are at a high risk daily of being sexual abused or item for human trafficking.

Section I: The Romanian Government will alter their penalty against sexual abuse and human trafficking. In Romanian convicted of sexual abuse or human trafficking can range from 3-12 years in prison and 5-15 years in prison if the victim is seriously injured or murdered.

Section II: The original penalties for disobeying the law will be replaced by the same penalties as the United States.

Section III: The punishment for these crimes will range from 15 years to life in prison or up to a 1.5 million dollar fine which will translate into 4980450 leu.

Section IV: This proposal will take effect 1 year after it's ratification.
