Title: **An act to send medical workers and MCK's to the small villages of the Congo**

**BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS**

Justification clause: With a civil war raging, soldiers are marching through villages of the Congo. These soldiers are going into women's and sometimes men's homes and sexually assaulting them. This means rape and beatings which most likely results in death or extreme injury. By training MCK's workers and providing care packages we can prevent more rape related deaths.

Section 1: An MCK is a medical care kit. Each kit will include some STD vaccines, bandages, antibiotics, and any other common household medical supplies. These kits are designed to take care of up to 200 people for 1 year.

Section 2: A kit and worker will be provided for each small village that is in constant soldier territory. Small huts can be sterilized and be used as medical clinics. If the government decides not to cooperate we plan to use the same system that we are currently using to send care packages to the troops in Afghanistan.

Section 3: The workers provided will come from the U.N. they will train a village worker to do the deeds of a registered nurse. The duties include the wrapping of wounds, vaccinations, medicating skills and know
