Title: **An act to provide Iraqi citizens with clean water, by building water wells.**

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause:

Iraq's water is polluted, and the Iraqi citizens have to walk many miles each day for just a small amount of dirty water that could give them waterborne diseases. If the disease is in the water when drank, it could kill you. Currently Syria and Iraq are in a nonviolent dispute over their water supply, this feud could turn violent. We could solve this dispute by placing wells in every heavily populated city in Iraq. The amount of wells depends on the number of people in that city.

Section I:

The purpose of our proposal is to place wells in each heavily populated city in Iraq. By doing this we will be able to stop the feud going on between Syria and Iraq, and also be providing fresh, clean water sources to the Iraqi citizens.

Section II:

We will determine the amount of wells by this: $\text{Population over 1,000,000: Population of country / Population in city} / 3$

$\text{Population under 1,000,000: Population of country / Population in city} / 2$

Section III:

The UN will provide us \$500,000 overall. Each well costs around \$10,000.

Section IV:

This proposal will go into effect on January 1st, 2014.
