Title: **An act to ensure that all businesses have 50% of all energy renewable by 2023.**

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: Pollution in the world is extremely high, especially in Germany. The only way to decrease pollution is by finding sources of renewable energy. It is imperative that Germany get the help it needs to become energy efficient.

Section I: Initially, businesses will be mandated to have 15% of all energy as renewable energy.

Section II: Businesses will be fined 2.5% of all profits if they do not comply. The fines will increase by 1% every month that are not in compliance.

Section III: The German government would use the fines from businesses to build and install windmills, water turbines, and solar panels to help produce energy.

Section IV: Energy companies will offer energy audits as well as monetary incentives for purchases of energy-saving appliances or products.

Section V: Since businesses will need a grace period to made upgrades and be compliant, this proposal will go into effect on January 1, 2014 until Germany's energy consumption is at an acceptable level.
