Title: **An act to increase the amount of clean drinking water for school children by adding water pumps.**

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: Only 50% of the water in Guatemala is usable. Because of this, the health and education of students across the country are negatively impacted on a daily basis. Children are missing school because they are sick due to the disgusting water conditions. Missing school means missing opportunities.

Section I: Because of the growing and continued success of local businesses, each company with 50 or more employees will donate 10% of their yearly profits to fund water pump installation by way of Water Step. 1,000 pumps will be installed each year for 10 years. Each school must get a pump.

Section II: The pumps cost approximately \$2500 a piece. The United Nations will donate 1/3 of the cost for the pumps, supplies, and installation (approximately \$8,000,000).

Section III: A task force including volunteers from Water Step will train locals to install, take care of, and repair the pumps once they are running. The locals will take on the responsibility after the task force leaves.

Section IV: This proposal will take effect immediately and expire in 2024.
