Title: An act to establish a nominal impost on all international exports and imports to in order to further the UN's global partnership for development.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: Traditionally, the UN has been financed and assessed by voluntary contributions from member states. Unfortunately, this is a generally unstable form of funding, and during times of economic recession in generous contributor states, the UN budget and their global efforts are considerably reduced. Through a nominal impost on international trade, the UN budget can be significantly strengthened with imperceptible effect on the world economy and better aid in establishing the UN Millennium Goals.

Section I:

A proposal to enact a .0001% impost on all international trade will be established to financially aid and reinforce the available funds of the UN.

Section II:

This impost will be overseen by the UN Economic and Security Council.

Section III:

The .0001% impost on the \$27 trillion international income will provide the UN with \$2.7 billion annually, approximately a 50% increase in the UN's yearly budget.

Section IV:

This bill will go into effect 1 year following its passage, giving the countries of the world time to collaborate and reach agreement on its implementation
