Title: An act to stop human trafficking and to help victims start new lives.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause:

Human trafficking is at an all-time high in Singapore. Hundreds of women are promised high paying jobs in Singapore by illegal recruiters. The women are then forced into sexual slavery. Currently, Singapore does not fully comply with the minimum requirements of the Trafficking Victims Protection Act (TVPA). This proposal calls for 20 million U.S. dollars from the U.N. to help create two new government agencies.

Section I: Our goal is to establish two new government organizations to help stop trafficking in Singapore. The Anti-Human Trafficking Agency of Singapore (AHTAS), and the Singaporean Trafficking Victims Protection Agency (STVPA).

Section II: The proposal would require \$20 million contribution from the U.N. to establish the agencies as well as to fund the staff necessary to run the agencies.

Section III: Human trafficking has grown significantly in Singapore over the past 10 years. In 2006 Singapore was moved from Tier 1 (little to no human trafficking) to Tier 2 (low to moderate human trafficking). The human trafficking victims in Singapore are coerced into the country from Thailand, Vietnam, Cambodia, India, The Philippines and The People's Republic of China, making this proposal of international importance.

Section IV: The AHTAS's responsibilities would include but not be limited to: Breaking up sex-trafficking rings; finding and prosecuting the traffickers, recruiters and anyone else involved in the trafficking; and directing victims to the STVPA for help in starting new lives. The STVPA would be in charge of finding housing, work, and counseling for victims of human trafficking.

Section V: This proposal will go into effect six months after its passage.
