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Title: **An act to provide aid and support to nations affected by tsunamis and other oceanic-related disasters**

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: Every year, coastal and island nations are affected by tsunamis and other oceanic-related natural disasters. These events take many lives, destroy thousands of acres of delicate coastal environments, and cost billions of dollars worldwide. This bill will help prevent the loss of lives and property by requiring and aiding in, the installation of tsunami-alert buoys along the countries' coasts.

Section 1: This bill would create a relief fund for those countries affected by oceanic-related natural disasters (i.e. tsunamis, hurricanes, tropical storms, etc.).

Section 2: This bill would require that half of the alert system be paid for by the UN and the other half be paid for by the country along whose coast the system is being installed.

Section 3: The installation of the program would be required by all countries with heavily populated coastal areas affected by such disasters.

Section 4: The proposal will go into effect on January 1, 2015.
