Title: **An act to receive a grant from the UN to construct water filtration, irrigation, and distribution center in Haiti.**

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause:

Haiti's water resources have been polluted and an unreliable source in nearly all areas. They are filled with bacteria, filth, and waste. Water is scarce but in high demand. By establishing filtration centers and irrigation system we may provide thousands of people with drinkable water.

Section I:

The United Nations will grant around \$50,000. \$25,000 will go to the purchase of individual filters around \$50 each making the amount of filters bought around 500. \$10,000 will go to the set up of these filters in various part of Haiti. \$10,000 will go to the construction of irrigation centers. \$5,000 will be distributed to centers along the irrigation centers to start producing new crops, some via hydroponics in area of poor soil quality. *1 US dollar= 42.5779 Haitian Gourdes

Section II:

These centers will be place along all of the rivers in Haiti: Artibonite, River de la Grand' Anse, River de Cavaillon, Trois River, River Momance, River du Limbe, Grande River du Nord, La ravine du Sud, River du Cu-de-Sac, and River de l'Estere.

Section III:

The country will begin to set up crops along the irrigation centers. Money earned by these government run crop-making facilities will be taxed until all of money from the UN's grant is refunded.

Section IV:

The proposal will go into effect 2 months after passage to allow construction blueprints to be prepared.

Section V:

The process will be overseen by the National Directorate for Water Supply and Sanitation in the Ministry of Public Works.
