Title: An act to establish a Kurdish homeland

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: With a reported 200,000 people killed in Iraq, 20,000 in Iran and another 20,000 in Turkey. Six million people have been displaced in Iraq and Turkey, and there has been 400 billion dollars in lost economic activity in Turkey. This information gives undeniable proof that this Kurdish conflict must be resolved to attain stability in the Middle East. This proposal successfully resolves the conflict.

Section I: To prevent further conflict between the Kurds and other nationalities, a Kurdish homeland will be established.

Section II: The new Kurdish homeland will be called Kurdistan.

Section III: The location of Kurdistan will be at the intersecting point of what is now Turkey, Iraq, and Iran which is primarily populated by Kurds and which will cede parts of these three nations.

Section IV: It is encouraged, while not mandatory, for Kurds to move to Kurdistan.

Section V: To ensure stability of this new nation, it will be a UN trusteeship region with UN help and advice during the creation of its government.

Section VI: If nations choose to ignore the UN request for the creation of this homeland, they will face embargo and a suspension of UN membership. Furthers sanctions can be created by the UN if necessary.

Section VII: People living in Kurdistan will be given dual citizenship between their old nation and Kurdistan.

Section VIII: This proposal will take effect as of January 2014.
