Title: An act for international recognition as an independent country from the United Kingdom.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: Scotland has a long, strong history of self governance and independent rule. We are already recognized by many countries and organizations as being independent from the United Kingdom, and we now wish to take that a step farther. For years, the UK has used us, and taken from us. When a relationship is no longer beneficial for both parties, that relationship must end.

Section I: Scotland would immediately be seen as an independent country and would have representatives and independent negotiating rights in treaties, trade deals, and legislation.

Section II: Scotland will vote independently in 2014 about whether to remain in the EU, and whether to use the "euro". All athletic competitors will compete internationally under the flag of Scotland exclusively.

Section III: All "Scots" involved in British military will be asked to return to Scotland and start the development of our own security forces. IF an agreement can be managed with the UK, then Scottish troops, officers, resources will be allowed to remain involved in missions, security, etc, but not under the UK flag alone.
