Title: **An act to create a universal policy for regulating carryon luggage for all international airlines and airports**

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: Statistics show that airlines with stricter regulations are less likely for accidents, by adding a common regulation accidents will be likely to occur.

Section I: The U.N. will only control regulations on the amounts of liquid allowed through security gates and the kinds of items permitted on international flights. Passengers of international flights will know the policy regulations and standards, which will help make the international flight process more efficient and safe for all parties involved.

Section II: This policy includes the following regulations:

- all liquids must be 3 ounces or less and in their original container
- all liquids must be able to fit into a single ziplock bag
- all medications must be in another separate ziplock bags.
- all of the items listed above must be taken out and put in a try together to go through the security check points

Section III: This policy prohibits any of the followings items:

- sharp objects (nail clippers, knives, etc.)
- sporting goods (baseball bats, clubs, etc.)
- guns and firearms
- tools
- marshal arts and self defense items
- explosives and flammable materials
- disabling chemicals and other hazardous items
- snow globes
- rocks
