Title: **An act to install a United Nation's appointed task force along the Spanish boarder to slow drug trafficking.**

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: Spain is known as a country with many commercial ties to the countries surrounding it. Its economy is heavily based on imports and exports to and from foreign countries. Many countries, however, are using their exports into Spain as fronts for illegal drug trafficking. Spain has laws regarding the use and possession of illegal drugs, but they do not search the foreign company's holdings or products as they are shipped into the country. Many times these individuals in charge of search and seizure are paid off or are given compensation to overlook various shipments. This, in turn, renders the money already given for these broken search and seizure programs useless.

Section I: In order to provide proper searches of companies' stock and exports into Spain, an additional border patrol shall be designated to search for illegal drugs and illicit monies brought into the country. This team shall consist of highly decorated narcotic specialists, law enforcement, research analysts, and negotiation specialists.

Section II: The border patrol programs shall be evaluated and, if they are seen to be doing their job poorly, shall be dismissed from their duties. The individuals within the department that are seen to be doing their jobs well and fully within the law shall be designated as members of the new border patrol.

Section III: The budget for this new faction shall be taken from the already existing budget that the Department of Transportation and Customs of Spain already has settled for border patrol personnel and activities of such groups.

Section IV: If any member of the new border patrol fails to comply with his job description, the individual shall be terminated from his place of work and a new specialist shall be elevated from the Department of Law Enforcement and placed on the new border patrol. The reasoning for this is to provide the best personnel possible to enforce the seizure of illegal drugs from companies attempting to work within Spain.

Section V: This proposal shall be enforced by the United Nations Drug Control Program.

Section VI: This proposal shall go into effect within 90 days after its passing, allowing for the members selected for the new border patrol to be trained and deployed swiftly according to their level of abilities.
