Title: An act to establish a council to assist nations being exploited by nation-building countries who are supposedly providing "humanitarian aid."

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause:

Throughout history and even in modern times, nations have been or are currently occupied by other countries wishing to administer "humanitarian aid" but are really trying to enact their own agenda. Military aid given to South American countries during the second half of the 20th century and to Middle Eastern nations today, promote the political beliefs of those nation-building countries. The partitioning of Africa at the Berlin Conference was used to endorse political beliefs, social ideals, and increase resources for the European countries involved at the expense of the native people.

Section I:

The United Nations will establish a 7-nation council whose role is to analyze a situation in which a country is being exploited by another country or countries who are supposed to be helping rebuild or "free" them.

Section II:

The council will be selected at random. However, the exploited nation and the manipulating nation/nations will be exempt from the selection process with the purpose of avoiding bias.

Section III:

In order for the council to become involved, a country's resources, economy, and/or governing system must be currently controlled or manipulated by the country who is administering aid.

Section IV:

Council will determine how much the offending country must pay in damages after evaluating the damage/ destruction that nation has caused.

Section V:

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS, this proposal will go into effect 90 days after passage.
