Title. An act to request funds for Cyclone Evan relief.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: The island of Samoa was recently devastated by Cyclone Evan. The category 4 storm, which hit the island on Dec. 13, 2012, collapsed houses and tourist facilities, washed away roads and bridges, damaged crops and water and electricity infrastructure. As a result, thousands of individuals have been left homeless. Also, businesses suffered damage which affects tourism for the island. Samoa needs assistance in providing relief to its citizens.

Section I: A formal request of \$50 million will be made by the people of Samoa. This request is made based on the calculations of property damage caused by Cyclone Evan.

Section II: Funding for this request will come directly from the United Nations and will be repaid by the country of Samoa when adequate funding is available.

Section III: This funding will go directly towards rebuilding what was destroyed by Cyclone Evan, and will help supply relief and supplies for those businesses and families whose homes, belongings, etc. were destroyed.

Section IV: It will be documented how much of the relief funds is spent to restore and repair damages. Let it also be documented that every supply purchased will only be used to replace what has been damaged or destroyed.
