Title: **An act to reduce the amount of time it takes to receive governmental assistance regarding housing.**

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: In Australia, 1 in 20 people are homeless. Over 1 billion people in the world lack adequate housing, and around 100 million have no housing. Twenty-one percent of homeless people living in Australia are homeless because of evictions or recent accommodations ending, or financial difficulty. Every day more than half of the people who report immediate accommodations from homeless services are turned away. The people being evicted from their homes do not have enough time or the financial means to relocate.

Section I: This proposal will ensure that applying for government assistance regarding housing will be faster and more effective.

Section II: This proposal will be enforced by the government of each country that is part of the United Nations.

Section III: Each country of the United Nations will be enforced to follow these programs.

Section IV: No additional funding will be needed to enact this program.

Section V: This program will be evaluated after 5 years. After the evaluation, changes could be made.

Section VI: This will go into effect January 1, 2014.
