Title: An act to: to mandate HICs to provide healthcare for all citizens of their country.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: Recently there has been a dramatic increase in the number of malicious diseases spreading across the world as well as an ever worsening global economy. HICs are countries that possess the funds to supply their citizens with proper healthcare, but refuse to do so. Healthcare is a right of every human and in countries that have the ability to provide healthcare for their citizens it should be mandatory. By mandating healthcare in these countries we may be able to stop this spread and increase the global economy at the same time.

Section I: Countries defined as a HIC must provide healthcare for all citizens of their respected countries.

HIC- countries have been classified by their level of development as measured by per capita gross national income (GNI). Accordingly, countries have been grouped as high-income, upper middle income, lower middle income and low-income (table E) those with incomes of more than \$12,276 as high-income countries "HIC". GNI per capita in dollar terms is estimated using the World Bank Atlas method and the classification in table E is based on data for 2010. This can be found in the statistical annex under Country classifications.

Section II: In 2 years' time if an HIC has not cooperated with this proposal the United Nations will revisit this issue and decide whether a sanction is necessary for a noncompliance nation.

Section III: Each individual HIC must provide their countries with the necessary funds to provide healthcare for all of its citizens.

Section IV: This proposal will go into effect 2 years after passage.
