Title: An act to increase awareness of sexually transmitted diseases through use of public media.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: In recent years, Japan's rate of sexually transmitted diseases has increased across the board. The amount of documented cases of gonorrhea has risen by 32%; the amount of chlamydia cases have risen by 36%. HIV rates are also on the rise, having risen more than 124% since 2001. The cause of these rising infection rates is predominantly a lack of public awareness and the stigma that comes along with having a sexually transmitted disease.

Section I: Television and radio announcements will be created, stressing the prevention of and proper testing for sexually transmitted diseases.

Section II: The announcements will be created by a board of United Nations Ambassadors.

Section III: Production of the announcements will be funded by the United Nations.

Section IV: This proposal will go into effect January of 2015, giving the Board of Ambassadors enough time to produce multiple adverts. Positive results are expected by January of 2016.
