Title: An act to prohibit the unlawful building of nuclear power plants over previous nuclear power plant sites.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: Kazakhstan is the world's leading source of uranium, which produces an abundant amount of nuclear energy. This bill wants to ensure that the nuclear waste and pollution cannot further affect those surrounding the older power plants. This proposal is created to thwart those trying to build onto old nuclear sites, which will create a mass amount of pollution and nuclear waste.

Section I: It must be required that when applying for a building permit, the contractors must include the location of the intended structure.

Section II: Funds will be denied, as well as building permits for the old nuclear sites.

Section III: A fine will be administrated to those failing to cooperate. A fine of 75,000 dollars will be issued to the corporation intending to build on old nuclear sites.

Section IV: Corporations, who fail to comply, will have their assets liquidated until they stop construction, pay the fine, and clean up the nuclear waste they have since created.

Section V: This proposal will go into effect within ninety days of passage.
