Title: An act to prevent illegal trafficking in Slovakia and all of the United Nation member nations.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: In 2012 an underground trafficking system was found in Slovakia. Illegal trafficking leads to crime, corruption, and high gang enrollment. In addition, the government loses tax money. By attempting to end illegal trafficking, there will be more peace and stability in the nation and better relationships among border nations.

Section I: Require stricter border control by adding more law enforcement officers. Also, conduct a yearly sweep of the borders and major cities.

Section II: Every January sweeps will take place in major cities and borders. Major cities will include the top 5 largest cities, including Bratislava, the capital.

Section III: The proposal will be funded by the United Nations office against drugs and crime. Slovakia's government will provide the special force officers for the searches.

Section IV: If any illegal trafficking is found, the violators will face charges according to the laws of their nation.

Section V: The proposal will go into effect a year after its passage.
