Title: **An act to provide each household with a LifeStraw Personal Water Filter.**

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: In Djibouti and other surrounding African nations, the water supply is running low and the little that can be found is contaminated. Many water treatments and filters have been tested and have failed in the rough conditions of Africa. LifeStraw Personal Water Filters are proven to be highly durable and last up to three years. This proposal will give each household in Djibouti one LifeStraw. One LifeStraw cost \$23.00 USD.

Section I: CARE, an organization working to provide clean water to countries in need, will create an establishment, donating \$4,000,000.00 USD to provide LifeStraw filters to 185,000 households in Djibouti.

Section II: The first year of this proposal's passage will be a trial for Djibouti. If the nation believes it worked well, the LifeStraw distribution will be spread to other surrounding African nations.

Section III: This proposal will go into effect upon passage.
