Title: A proposal to collaborate with UNODC to compose a task force to abolish human trafficking.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: There has been an worldwide increase in human trafficking crimes especially in China. Human trafficking is defined as an act of recruiting, transporting, transferring, harbouring or receiving a person through a use of force, coercion or other means, for the purpose of exploiting them. By abolishing these inhumane crimes the residents of China and many other UN countries will be able to live their lives without the fear of human trafficking.

Section I: Participating countries will compose a human trafficking task force to specialize on abolishing human trafficking crimes. The task force will be composed of soldiers with military experience as well as specialized police forces.
