Title: **An act to distribute water filtration systems to every household in Cuba**

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: Every day 14,000 people die because of water related illnesses. In Cuba, the water is often contaminated by pollution and a lack of filtration systems. Rural areas are where the water pollution is the strongest. Many rural families collect rain water in open containers. These containers often contain insects, bacteria and traces of fecal matter, which can lead to illnesses or even death. Many illnesses such as diarrhea have been reported due to this issue. This situation can be easily fixed by using water filtration systems. However, most people in Cuba don't have enough money to purchase the systems.

Section 1: The UNICEF organization will provide Solvatten water filtration systems to every household in Cuba.

Section 2: The system will cost about \$35.00 plus additional training costs.

Section 3: Cuban citizens will be trained by current water system employees in how to use the new water filtration systems. They will go door to door and teach each household how to setup the filtration systems. They would start in rural areas.

Section 4: UNICEF will pay for the filtration systems, and they will pay the people who are teaching and delivering the filtration systems. They will model the training and systems off of current water systems in place in Kenya.

Section 5: This proposal will go into affect one year after this passes to allow time for planning and training.
