Title: An act to stop human trafficking in Denmark.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: Human trafficking is a big issue in Denmark. Women, Men, and Children are bought and sold to different people, and are held against their will as slaves. Statistics show there's an estimated 4,000-6,000 sex slaves, hard laborers, and child soldiers. They can't leave or escape without their family being harmed, killed, or threatened. Presently a slave is sold and bought for 90 USD, but it costs the victim or slave so much more. It costs them their freedom, confidence, emotional and physical wellbeing, being able to feel safe and so much more!

Section I: Undercover authorities will be assigned to infiltrate places where human trafficking activity is suspected. When they arrive they won't be needing their appointment. They will go in and arrest the authority figures over the slaves, and free the enslaved. The initial cost will be 250,000 USD, for the year. This will pay the undercover authorities salaries. Each undercover authority person will get paid around 50,000 dollars a year. More or less depending on how many people they have caught, and slaves they have freed. Knowing that they could get paid more if they catch more slave owners and free more slaves, will persuade them to strive to catch more and more every day.

Section II: After the undercover authorities have infiltrated some of the places where human trafficking is suspected, we will put up rehabilitation centers for the women, men, and children who have been rescued and freed. Anyone after getting out of that is going to need restoring. These rehabilitation centers will help them wipe away the remnants of their scaring human trafficking experiences. It will also help the men and women prepare to get back out into the real world. For the children, they will help them feel secure and safe, they will also find out if they have any family they can go and live with or put them in a safe, secure, and well known and recommended, foster home.

Section III: There is an organization called "The End It Movement." They are fighting to end modern day slavery in the U.S. We are going to partner with them, to get them to expand their fight to end slavery in Denmark. When they put this on their website, www.enditmovement.com, millions of people will see this and join/donate to the fight to end human trafficking. Not only will this help with getting the word out there about human trafficking and what we are trying to do, but it will also help with the cost because when people donate it will help pay for the undercover authorities maybe so much that we can pay for more undercover authorities.
