Title: An act to establish and affordable and revisable World Wide Health Care System

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: Expensive, mediocre, and even less than effective healthcare is a huge problem in so many countries. This proposal will establish a new, world-wide, revisable, health care system. This proposal aims at establishing world-wide health care in all countries that wish to take part in the system. They will have more affordable health care for all of its citizens. This proposal will not only help France, but other countries as well.

Section I: We invite all countries to take part in this new system of healthcare. To qualify for participation, countries will be required to take a census. Only countries choosing to participate will be required to take a census.

Section II: To decide how all citizens of varying nations will pay for this system, the countries will be divided into three population groups. They will be LOWER, MIDDLE, and UPPER CLASS. The lower class will be the bottom 60% of worldwide income when converted to USD. The adjacent 30% of worldwide income when converted to USD will be the MIDDLE CLASS. The top 10% (UPPER CLASS) will pay a higher rate than the lower and middle classes.

Section III: The United Nations will sponsor a Health Care Embassy in each country who wishes to take part in this new system. The cost for each embassy will be paid off in time, after the embassy makes revenue from the healthcare system.

Section IV: This will will go into effect 90 days after passage.
