Title: **An act to provide universal healthcare to all existing countries within the United Nations.**

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: The most developed 33 countries in the world currently have universal healthcare, including, but not limited to Brazil, South Korea, China, and Great Britain. Universal health care provides healthcare and financial protection to all its citizens. In December 2012, the United Nations General Assembly adopted a resolution urging governments to move towards providing all people with access to affordable, quality health-care services. The resolution emphasizes the important role that health plays in achieving international development goals.

Section 1: United Healthcare is beneficial and necessary to all participating United Nation countries, because it ensures proper medical attention to all citizens regardless of financial stability or lack thereof. This proposal will establish universal healthcare for all countries within the United Nations.

Section 2: In order to provide universal healthcare services for all United Nation countries, our proposal requires a minimal national tax increase of .25%, in order to offset the cost of this proposal.

Section 3: All United Nation countries will be required within three years of passage to implement a form of universal healthcare. Countries not meeting this requirement after three years will be fined per individual who are not provided healthcare.

Section 4: A .25% national tax increase will provide the additional funding needed to support this proposal.

Section 5: This proposal will go into effect upon passage.
