Title: **An act to create an additional education program, SEFA, to assist Education For All with meeting their 2015 goals.**

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: An organization that works, not only in Haiti, to improve education worldwide is UNESCO (United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization). Currently, all United Nations countries are participating in UNESCO's program called Education For All (EFA). Unfortunately, there are too many nations that are not on track of meeting EFA's goals by 2015.
