Title: **An act to decrease the level of poverty in Israel.**

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause:

23.6 percent of the population in Israel is below the poverty line (\$7.30 per person a day) due to high unemployment. Many have lost their homes because they can no longer afford the payment and the gap between rich and poor is getting wider. We propose to help citizens find affordable housing in Israel.

Section I:

The United Nations Development Programme provides 1 billion a year towards countries struggling with poverty. We propose that a portion of that money goes to Israel to help people find affordable housing.
