Title: An act to create refugee camps in peaceful countries

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: Clause: All throughout human history war has plagued mankind. It creates a wide swath of destruction and leaves behind widows, orphans and shattered communities. Many times throughout history and still today, people flee from the conflicted country in hopes to find a safer, better place to stay until the violent issues are resolved.

Section I: One permanent refugee camp is to be constructed in each of the following countries: the Netherlands, Switzerland, Finland, Canada, Panama, Turkmenistan, Qatar, Vietnam and the Democratic Republic of the Congo. These countries have been chosen because of their strategic locations and constant internal peace. The camps are for any person, no matter what country of origin, who is affected or displaced by war, so they may have a place which to flee.

Section II: These camps will be constantly occupied by United Nations Peacekeeping Forces to ensure the safety and wellbeing of people being sheltered. If a country that is hosting a refugee camp is attacked, the Peacekeeping forces will only act to protect the people being sheltered in the camp.

Section III: Each camp must be able to accommodate 50,000. The country will be responsible for designing and building the camp, but the United Nations will provide full funding for building and operating each camp. The camps will need people to operate in both peace and war times. Each country must provide the personnel to provide for the camps. The personnel may be either volunteers or paid workers.

Section IV: The funding to provide food, water and other resources needed to create a safe refugee camp will be provided by the United Nations. Camps will become self-sufficient by creating a work training program for the refugees. This will also prepare the refugees for life after they depart from the camp through a learned trade.

Section V: Each refugee camp will contain shelter, a school, a hospital, an administration office, quarters for the Peacekeeping forces and a kitchen area for food preparation. Every year an inspection will be held to make sure that the refugee camps are functioning properly and meet the United Nations' guidelines for refugee camps.

Section VI: This proposal shall take effect 24 months after passage.
