Title: An act to stop the production of illicit drugs in Poland.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause:

Poland is one of the largest producers of synthetic illicit drugs in Eastern Europe. Our proposal aims to stop the production of these drugs in Poland. Stopping illicit drug production will make Poland a healthier country and reduce the crime rate associated with drug use and trafficking.

Section I:

The UNIDCP (United Nations International Drug Control Programme) will assist the Polish government in establishing drug eradication programs similar to those established in Asian and Central American areas. These methods include crop eradication, the detection of illicit laboratories, and the control of chemicals used in the manufacturing of illicit drugs.

Section II:

The UNIDCP will assist the Polish Government in setting up a special task force for carrying out the measures of the drug eradication programs. This task force will be responsible for finding and arresting drug producers and enforcing the laws.

Section III:

The UNIDCP will provide the funds for education and assisting the special task force for two years. The Polish government will provide funds for the task force activities.
