Title: An act to hold the sovereign state accountable for all costs of maintaining, operating, and housing weapons of mass destruction.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: Scotland houses the United Kingdom's most well-known weapon of mass destruction, Trident. Even though Scotland does not fully support such weapons, the United Kingdom chose to place Trident there due to its tactical location. The housing of Trident has forced Scotland to significantly increase its defense expenditures and incur substantial maintenance costs.

Section I: All costs of maintaining, operating, and housing weapons of mass destruction will be the responsibility of the sovereign state and no cost will fall on the country or territory where the weapon resides.

Section II: The sovereign state will allocate a stipend for increased defense expenditures to the country or territory where weapons of mass destruction reside. If a weapon of mass destruction must be moved, the sovereign state will incur all of the costs of transportation.

Section III: This proposal will be enacted on January 1st, 2014.
