Title: **An act to reduce pollution levels in the Republic of Korea/South Korea.**

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: Looking out for the best interests of not only our country, but also for our surrounding countries; we as citizens of The Republic of Korea plan to reduce sizable levels of pollution by cutting down on coal, and increasing our usage of hydroelectricity, wind energy, and solar energy; thereby making the air cleaner for the Korean peninsula and setting an example to the world.

Section I: Coal refineries across the nation will be replaced with cleaner energy producers (e.g. hydroelectric dams, wind turbines, and solar panels).
