Title: An act to to enforce a new set of United Nations laws in Europe to control the anonymous drop off of infants.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: In Europe, infants are being anonymously dropped off in baby boxes. To solve this growing problem we propose that the United Nations introduce a series of regulations that state that all participating parties are expected to follow the regulation that infants can only be anonymously dropped off within thirty days of birth. Infants must be placed in certain areas such as hospitals and police offices, where they can receive the needed attention and care.

Section I: This proposal affects all current and future members of the United Nations.

Section II: This proposal will decrease the number of infants dropped off anonymously within approximately five years.

Section III: This proposal will be enacted in all nations that are members of the United Nations and will mainly be regulated in Europe.

Section IV: This proposal will be enacted by the first of January 2014.
