Title: An act to promote the use of wind energy around the world.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Justification Clause: Sweden has one of the most highly developed wind energy systems in the world; consisting of around 40 wind farms that supply energy all over Sweden. Our country has greatly benefitted from the use of wind turbines, and we would like to pass this on to other countries.

Section I: We propose to partner with the Swedish Wind Energy Association (SWEA) and the United Nations (UN) to provide an incentive program for countries willing to install wind turbines in their country. In doing so, we will provide them a \$100,000 bonus every 10 years, along with paying for 25% of the total installation cost.

Section II: Our natural resources are rapidly depleting, and our current forms of electricity are harmful to the environment. Coal emits carbonic fumes into the air, resulting in pollution that makes our air filthy. However, wind energy is the perfect alternative. Our objective is to supply a healthier, more environmentally friendly source of energy.

Section III: The funds needed for this program will include the cost of the bonuses and 25% of the installation price. The cost of one wind turbine is approximately \$1.8 million, thus we will pay \$450,000 of it. The money will come from our partners, SWEA and the UN.

Section IV: This will go into effect at the start of 2015.
