An act to prevent the spread of White-nose Syndrome.

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: The purpose of this bill is to prevent spreading of White-nose Syndrome. Additional research facilities to monitor bat populations will be established.

Section 2: This bill will permit wildlife officials to monitor bat populations statewide.

Section 3: This bill will install surveillance to keep track of bat populations most effected by the disease.

Section 4: This bill will fund the Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife from earmarks through revenue.
