- 1 An act to establish health code inspections and ratings on food delivery vehicles.
2
- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
- 5 Section 1: Health code inspections and ratings for food delivery vehicles will be established to ensure health
6 of customers and reduce contamination of food.
7
- 8 Section 2: A .5% tax will be assessed on food purchased for delivery.
9
- 10 Section 3: The tax will pay for the additional inspectors needed.
11
- 12 Section 4: Health inspectors will be looking for cleanliness, a smoke-free environment, and other typical
13 conditions searched for during restaurant inspections.
14
- 15 Section 5: Inspections should not be announced ahead of time.
16
- 17 Section 6: Each delivery vehicle will be given a grade.
18
- 19 Section 7: Low health ratings of delivery vehicles will affect the overall rating of the restaurant.
20
- 21 Section 8: Restaurants are required to inform the customer of the delivery vehicle score when placing the
22 order.
23
- 24 Section 9: All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this bill are hereby considered null and void.
25
- 26 Section 10: The bill shall go into effect by January 1, 2014.
