1 An act to recognize all provisional drivers with a magnet displayed on their car.

2  
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

4  
5 Section 1: To insure the safety of provisional drivers and those with full driving rights, all provisional drivers  
6 must display a magnet explaining their driving status on the back of their vehicle on the left rear hand  
7 corner.

9 Section 2: The importance of a magnet is for the safety of new drivers so people around them can  
10 acknowledge that they are new to driving.

11  
12 Section 3: The cost of your first magnet will be \$2.00. This will change your permit fees from \$12.00 to  
13 \$14.00 when you receive your permit. Extra magnets will cost \$1.00.

14  
15 Section 4: If you are pulled over, and the magnet is not displayed in the correct place, you will be fined  
16 \$75.00 and will have one point deducted from your license.

17  
18 Section 5: This bill will be in effect six months after passage to allow the magnets to be made.
