1 An act to require all Kentucky drivers to retake their driver's test every 10 years
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: This bill requires all Kentucky drivers to retake their driver's test every ten years from the date
6 they receive their original license.
7
8 Section 2: The driving test will include vision testing, hearing test, as well as drug testing.
9
10 Section 3: If you fail the drug portion of the retesting process, you cannot drive or retake the test to one
11 year. Once eligible to retake the test in hopes of regaining your license, you must be able to provide proof of
12 successful drug counseling and/or rehabilitation.
13
14 Section 4: If you do not pass the vision or hearing parts of the test, you must get prescription glasses or a
15 hearing aid before you will be eligible to continue driving.
16
17 Section 5: If the citizen fails the driving portion of the test, you are eligible to retake the test in four months.
18 If you fail again at that time, you must wait a year to retake the test.
19
20 Section 6: This will go into effect May 1, 2014
