- 1 An act to place a \$10 fee on all traffic court fines to go toward cancer research

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: A \$10 fee will be placed on all traffic court fines to fund research on cures for cancer.
- 6
- 7 Section 2: The money accessed from these court taxes will be given to the American Cancer Society.
- 8
- 9 Section 3: The Kentucky Department of Transportation will be responsible to collect all traffic fines and
- 10 deliver the fund to the American Cancer Society.
- 11
- 12 Section 4: The \$10 fee will only affect individuals who have violated traffic laws.

- 14 Section 5: This bill will go into effect in January 1st 2014.
