An act to delay driving permits for minors under the age of 16 that have any previous drug and/or alcohol convictions.

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: Juveniles who are convicted of a drug and/or alcohol crime will receive the following punishments in addition to incarceration and/or fines

1st offense – 60 day delay on permit and 10 hours of community service.

2nd offense – 120 day delay on permit and 20 hours of community service.

3rd offense - 180 day delay on permit and 40 hours of community service.

12 4th offense - Cannot get permit until 18th birthday and 60 hours of community service

Section 2: Bill will go into effective immediately after passage.
