1 An act to delay driving permits for minors under the age of 16 that have any previous drug and/or alcohol
2 convictions.

4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
5

6 Section 1: Juveniles who are convicted of a drug and/or alcohol crime will receive the following punishments
7 in addition to incarceration and/or fines
8

9 1st offense - 60 day delay on permit and 10 hours of community service.
10 2nd offense - 120 day delay on permit and 20 hours of community service.
11 3rd offense - 180 day delay on permit and 40 hours of community service.
12 4th offense - Cannot get permit until 18th birthday and 60 hours of community service
13

14 Section 2: Bill will go into effective immediately after passage.
