- 1 An act to cut down animal abuse by forcing the abusers to volunteer at an animal shelter.

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: This bill will require citizens of Kentucky to serve 100 hours of community service over a five week
- 6 period. They will volunteer at a local animal shelter if they are convicted of animal abuse.
- 7
- 8 Section 2: If the citizens fail or refuse to serve the community service hours within the time period they will
- 9 be fined \$1000.00.
- 10
- 11 Section 3: If the citizens fail to pay the \$1000.00 fine then they will serve a mandatory jail sentence in the
- 12 local community jail doing community service until the fine has been paid.

- 14 Section 4: This bill will go into effect January 1, 2014.
