1                                    An act to Remove Political Party Designations from Ballots in Kentucky

3                                    **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: Straight party voting option will be removed from and prohibited on all ballots.  
6  
7 Section 2: Candidates will have no party identification next to their names on the ballot  
8  
9 Section 3: Current state funding of elections covers any cost. Any counties not in compliance will lose  
10 election funding for the next election and the county will be fined \$5000.00 per voting machine not in  
11 compliance. State Election Commissioners will monitor compliance.  
12  
13 Section 4: This bill will go into effect 6 months after signed into law.
