6 7 8 9 10 11	Section I: The purpose of this bill is to require all Kentucky public school students', grades 6–8, six hours of community service upon promotion to the high school. Our bill is an attempt to lay the foundation for actively involving Kentucky school students in community-based projects. In addition, this requirement will create a better sense of appreciation for ones community and self-worth.
12 13 14 15	Section II: Community service is a volunteer service intended to help people of a particular community or organization. With the passage of our bill, students will be exposed to various types of community volunteer work and will further connect them to their community, state, and world.

However, it ultimately impacts thousands of people that are volunteering, distributing ideas of types of service, the community that receives that work, and the people who are organizing the initial projects.
