1 2	An act to require a five day waiting period before a firearm is transferred to the purchaser.
3 4	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
5 6 7 8 9	Section 1: In an attempt to insure domestic tranquility, promote the general welfare, as well as secure the blessings of liberty to the people of the United States as called for in the Preamble to our Constitution, this bill will require a five day waiting period between the time a firearm is purchased and the time it is actually transferred to the purchaser.
10 11 12 13	Section 2: The purpose of the waiting period is to allow for a "cooling off" period to hinder impulsive, violent acts, while not infringing upon the rights of citizens to bear arms as allowed for in the second ammendment to our Constitution.
14 15 16	Section 3: Ten states and the District of Columbia have waiting periods that apply to the purchase of some or all firearms.
17 18 19 20	Section 4: In the case of temporary gun shows, guns purchased will be held by a local designated Federal Firearm Licensed dealer for pick up by the purchaser after the required 5 day waiting period expires. Reasonable transfer/holding fees will be included in the cost to the purchaser.
21 22 23	Section 5: Exceptions to this waiting period will be made for handgun purchasers already in possession of an official unexpired Concealed Carry Weapons Permit.
24 25 26	Section 6: Firearms sellers found to be in violation of this law will be fined \$2500 for their first offense and will lose their license for the second offense.
27	Section 7: This law will go into effect 3 months after passage.
