An act to to have yearly car inspections in the state of Kentucky

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: This act will require vehicles by regulation, in the state of Kentucky, to be in a secure working state when driven on a main street or roadway.

- Section 2: The things that will be inspected on automobiles will consist of:
- Seat Belts- Every vehicle is required to have one or more seat belts for each person
- Brakes- While checking the brakes on a vehicle the inspector looks to make sure that the brake pedal is in proper operation. They will check for leakage and proper fluid level, and thickness of brake pad linings.
- Steering, Front End, Suspension, and Frame- The inspector will check that the steering wheel does not have excessive free play. They will also check for missing or broken parts.
- Tires- A tires tread depth must be at least 2/32 inch when measured. The tire pressure will be checked and must be within the manufacturer's recommendation.
- Lights- All lighting must be of an approved type and inspected for operation, proper mounting, and broken or
 missing lenses.
- Windshield and Other Glass- No crack of 11 inches long or longer is allowed if any part of the crack is within the area cleared by the windshield wiper. Wipers will be checked for presence and operation.
- 20 Horn- Check mounting and operation
- 21 Fuel Leaks- Any fuel leak that causes dripping or pooling is not acceptable.
 - Emissions Inspection- Includes Each emissions inspection confirms the presence and connection of the vehicle's required emissions control devices. This includes making sure that the vehicle's gas cap is present, is in good condition, and fits properly.

Section 3: If the vehicle passes the regulation check, a sticker will be given to place on the car indicating the date when the car has been checked and when it will be re-inspected every year on the same month.

Section 4:If the vehicle does not pass the regulation test, it is not permitted to drive on a main street or roadway. If a vehicle is driving on a main street or roadway with an expired sticker, a fine will be paid of \$250.00 and must be checked as soon as possible.
